## The Technical Support Instrument (TSI)



TSI is the EU Commission's programme that provides tailor-made technical expertise to EU Member States to design and implement reforms.

Covers a wide range of reform areas, at any stage of reform



Public financial management and revenue administration



Governance and public administration



Sustainable growth and business environment



Labour market, education, health and social services



Financial sector and access to finance

## **Features of the Technical Support Instrument**

#### Unique

Instrument brings expertise rather than funding to Member States, tapping into an EU wide pool of experts.

#### **Demand-driven and light burden**


Demand-driven, burden-free for beneficiaries, and no co-financing for Member States.

#### Flexible and EU-wide

Address reform needs across policy areas and can easily be adapted to current and future challenges and crises.

#### **Capacity building**

Focus on strengthening the capacity of public administrations to design and implement reforms.



#### Tailor-made approach

The TSI consists of support on the ground, which is praised and increasingly demanded by the Member States given the tailor-made approach.

#### **Accompanying Member States**

Close involvement of DG REFORM staff: working together with the Member States authorities and the contracted providers in the delivery of the projects in all phases of project cycle management.

#### Independent

Not specifically linked to any other EU funds: TSI can provide support to any reforms independently of it being funded by EU or Member States.

#### Largest instrument of technical support

TSI is the single largest instrument providing technical support to MS in the MFF.





### TSI support in the context of the RRF

- Support can be provided for the "preparation, amendment and revision of recovery and resilience plans [...] and the implementation thereof undertaken by Member States" – Art. 9(d) of TSI Regulation
- 2 types of support:
  - General support, horizontally applicable, for a smooth implementation of the RRPs
  - 2. Thematic support, targeting specific reforms and investments in the RRPs

## General support for the implementation of RRPs



## Building capacities for effective communication of the benefits of the Recovery and Resilience Plans

The Commission will support Bulgaria, Belgium, Cyprus, Netherlands, Latvia, the Portugal, Romania and Spain in further enhancing their capacities for fulfilling the communication requirements related the implementation of the Recovery and Resilience Plans.



## Description of support (under preparation)

- The project includes a stream of common support measures for all beneficiary Member States. This includes a series of capacity building activities on RRP communication (i.e. trainings and workshops).
- The project also entails country specific support measures (i.e. design and production of awareness raising communication material for the RRPs, development of country specific RRP communication manuals, development of communication plans, piloting of country specific communication campaigns etc.).

## General technical support for the implementation of Portugal's RRP

The Commission is supporting Portugal in enhancing its RRP implementation, monitoring, reporting, risk assessment, control and audit mechanisms.



#### **Description of support** (ongoing)

- Enhancing data collection, monitoring and reporting mechanisms for the reforms and investments contained in the RRP
- Strengthening the evaluation of the RRP reforms and investments
- Enhancing the audit and control mechanism for the RRP
- Mapping the RRP investments & drafting an investment management framework
- Capacity building activities for Taskforce Recuperar Portugal
- Capacity building activities on the application of the "Do no significant harm" (DNSH) principle

The Commission is supporting Belgium with the introduction and institutionalisation of spending reviews at federal level, as well as at regional level, as set out in component 6 of the national RRP.



The Commission is supporting **Bulgaria** with the implementation of selected priorities in **the National Strategy for Financial Literacy** and action plan, as set out in component 1 of the national RRP.



## Example of a thematic RRP support project (2/2)





The Commission is supporting Italy with the preparation of a national strategy and action plan to strengthen the general digital skills of healthcare professionals, as well as specific skills to implement the use of Electronic Health Records, as set out in component 2 of the national RRP.



The Commission is supporting Malta in delivering sustainable transport through the provision of a Feasibility Study on Hydrogen for Transport in Malta and Gozo, a Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan and a Sustainable Urban Logistics Plan, as set out in component 2 of the national RRP.



## Support for the RRP implementation under TSI 2025

**General & thematic support** available to Member States under TSI 2025

- While the TSI may provide input to help achieve RRP measures, Member States <u>remain fully responsible</u> for RRP implementation
- Need for careful alignment between the timelines of RRP reforms and investments & the TSI project deliverables
  - For TSI 2024, reforms/investments preferably with a related DDL in Q1 2026 or later







### **Multi-country Projects**

A <u>multi-country</u> or <u>multi-region</u> project is a technical support project that is relevant or **common to more than one Member State** as it belongs to the **same policy area** and addresses the **same priorities** for technical support



#### **Modes to submit multi-country requests**

#### **IN PARALLEL**

Coordinated submission of similar requests by different Member States.

Each Member State initiates and submits autonomously a request in the system and mentions the participating Member States.

**Flexible support measures:** The support measures requested by each authority might be adapted to the needs of each Member State.

#### **ON BEHALF**

Request submission by one Member State on behalf of other Member States

A lead Member State initiates a request in the system and invites selected participants. Each invited authority must submit a sub-request.

**Identical support measures** to all participating authorities, as included by the Lead authority.









#### Recovery and Resilience Plans

The European Commission, via the Technical Support Instrument (TSI), has been helping Member States to design reforms necessary for the preparation and implementation of their national RRPs. So far, more than 300 projects approved under the TSI are linked to the preparation or implementation of Member States' RRPs. TSI assistance has taken the form of general support, horizontally applicable for a smooth implementation of the plans, and thematic support, targeting specific reforms and investments in the RRPs.


# Annex I - Additional information on the Repository of reform support needs

### The repository, why?

(1/2)

- Since TSI 2021 the number of multicountry projects has increased, resulting in a higher number of supported reforms.
- TSI 2025 priorities: there is a growing interest on multicountry and multiregional projects to exploit synergies and complementarities.





Need to find a mechanism to allow coordinating authorities and beneficiary authorities to find out what requests other countries are planning to submit

### The repository, why?

(2/2)

- A repository was piloted for TSI 2023 via a survey through Coordinating Authorities (but no direct involvement of beneficiary authorities).
- Changes on the multicountry on-behalf process under TSI 2024 made the Repository particularly relevant for next TSI call.



Changes in the process:

Beneficiary Authorities have an active role in the upload of ideas, expressions of interest, exchanges, etc.

**Dynamic repository**, with the possibility to follow the evolution of dialogue between potential project beneficiaries

### Repository of reform support needs under TSI

- System to gather <u>individual</u> support needs uploaded by different Member States, and to provide a space for discussion.
- To identify synergies for potential creation of multi-country (multi-regional) requests ahead of the TSI 2025 submission.
- Informal and Non-Committal exercise to identify authorities with similar needs.
- The mechanism does not replace any of the formal procedures for submission of requests for TSI support.

### **Audience and potential roles**

- Potential Beneficiary Authorities (BAs), with ideas on their support needs\*.
   They can: (1) upload support needs, (2) see other Beneficiary Authorities' needs, and (3) contact them when interested.
- 2. Coordinating Authorities (CAs). They have the same rights as BAs to upload, see, and contact. They <u>can</u>: (1) act on behalf of BAs, and/or (2) analyse submissions to spot / keep track / coordinate interesting synergies.
- 3. DG REFORM: can share analysis of potential synergies to help interested Authorities in designing joint requests.





### The Repository: 3 main modules

"Submit a new idea for support": simple form with 8 mandatory fields to include the authority support needs. A new page is created for each uploaded idea.

Table of "All submitted ideas": provides an overview of all uploads. It can be filtered by Country/Policy area, and allows extraction of the selection. Through it you can access the page of each individual idea.

Contact module: to express interest in an idea and get in direct contact with the author.

Visibility on the comments of other interested authorities. It <u>includes a notification system</u> for all contributors.

   Authorities to upload reform support needs in the Repository
- 2. BAs will submit their reform support needs
- CAs and BAs can check the information uploaded by others and can contact other CAs and BAs in the platform based on synergies.
